Marion		Marion County Park District	Marion Tallgrass Trail - Phase 3	\$667,000.00	\$500,000.00	Phase III of construction of Marion County's first recreational trail. Phase III will add about 3.03 miles of paved trail, moving westward from the end of phase II
Medina	City of	Wadsworth	Inner Urban Trail	\$506,685.00	\$372,185.00	Development of a 2 mile long 10 ft wide asphalt bike trail. This trail project will follow the Northern Ohio Traction and Light Company's light rail line from downtown Wadsworth to Barberton.
Meigs	Village of	Middleport	MEG-Middleport Trail	\$2,344,050.00	\$225,048.00	Construction of 1.6 miles of multi-use trail along the Ohio River in the Village of Middleport. The northern terminus of the trail will link to Mason, West Virginia. The middle portion of this trail will link into Diles Park.
Montgomery	City of	Clayton	National Road Trail	\$628,005.00	\$241,333.00	4,480 linear feet of 10 foot wide multi-use trail running along the south side of National Road from Hoke Rd. to Northmont Middle and High School. Additional link to Englewood Metropark Regional Bike Trail.
